### **About you**

- Could you describe your position in your organization?
- How many years of professional development experience do you have?
- How many years have you been in this kind of role?
- How often do you encounter conflicts in this position?

### **General perception of conflicts:**

- Do merge conflicts seem to have a particular size?
  - Do you notice that certain sizes are easier or harder to resolve?
- Are there any particular time frames that you've noticed when merges are particularly difficult? Say, near a release or something related to software development phases?
- Are there any instances where you have to merge code and wish that you had more information?
